

**GREAT PLAINS TECHNOLOGY CENTER
STUDENT AUCTION EXPLANATION
2011 - 2012**

GPTC students start accumulating “auction bucks” August 22, 2011. These auction bucks can be used to bid on prizes during the student auction in the spring.

The auction (**one combined auction for morning and afternoon students**) will be held on **Tuesday, May 1, 2012**. Any student who has accumulated a minimum of **3000** auction bucks will be allowed to bid on prizes. An actual auctioneer will conduct the bidding. Following the auction, those who were not able to “buy” an item, may put their name in a drawing. Fifteen names will be drawn, and those fifteen will automatically win one of the auction items that has been set aside specifically for the drawing.

A running total of each student’s accumulated auction bucks will be kept by GPTC until the week preceding the auction. At that time, students who have earned auction bucks will receive their total from the Activities Coordinator or their instructor.

Auction bucks are not transferable and only the student who was awarded the auction bucks can redeem them at the auction.

Students who are sanctioned for disciplinary reasons (including suspensions) will forfeit some or all auction bucks accumulated (either cumulatively up to that point or for that nine-week period) based on the severity of the disciplinary action taken.

Every program will be required to contribute **at least** one prize of a value of **not less than \$50**.

School attendance policy is followed, i.e., 3 tardies = 1 absence. However just 1 tardy lowers student to 1 absence because it is no longer “perfect” attendance.

If an adult is in more than one program, he/she receives auction bucks from the a.m. class only.
